Harikar Projects by Cluster



Protection and legal aid are UNHCR funded projects implemented by Harikar NGO through which protection and legal services are offered for syrian and non-Syrian asylum seekers and refugees and internally displaced persons in Duhok governerate in camp and non-camp areas and some desputed areas within Nineveh governorate. The project provides legal aid services including, legal counselling, legal awareness raising and representation before courts. Protection and community based monitoring for people of concern is conducted for refugees and internally displaced persons including protection assessment, case/gap identification, and case management and support for persons with specific needs and extremely



Harikar NGO runs registration process for camp and non-camp Syrian refugees and asylum seekers in partnership with UNHCR through its established registration centers in Domiz 1, Gawilan, and Akre camps and through the outreach verification/ registration in urban areas. The registration process is based on standard UNHCR forms and database to assure availability of all required information whenever needed; it is implemented as per UNHCR protocols for registration, documentation and filing.



In The livelihood cluster we have two projects, the first one funded by ASB/BMZ and another funded by CARE-BMZ that conducts distribution of greenhouses, agregulture inputes, drip irrigation system and hand tools, this project alwasys conducts social cohision sessions for femail headed households and students and Mmrket rehabilitation in Zumar and Sinjar Area.

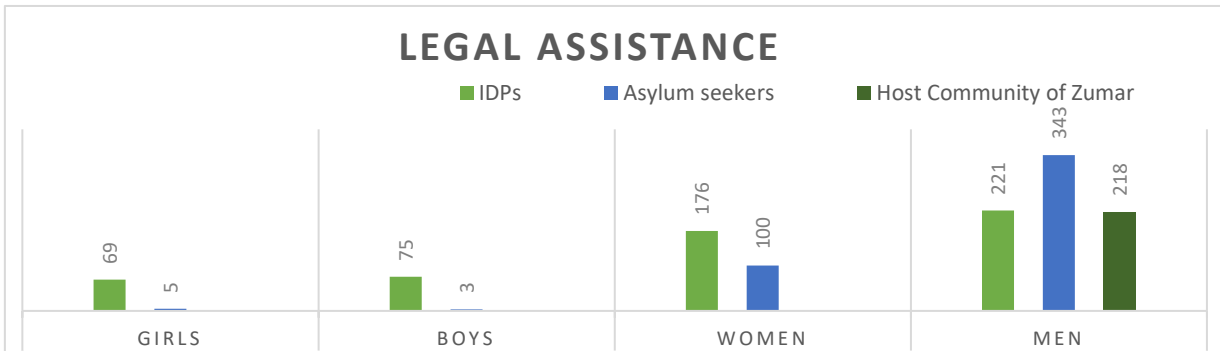


As for GBV sub-cluster, Harikar NGO have four projects, the first of which is Enhancing GBV prevention and response intervention available to highly displaced vulnerable persons and survivors brutalized by the exposure to violence in newly reclaimed area of Baashiqa, funded by UNOCHA/IHF. Two more projects are funded by UNFPA and UNOCHA in partnership with DORCAS as consurtium to scale up GBV programming in Sinjar and Sinuni by targeting the remote villages which are hard to reach, in Dohuk and Nineveh governorate: Domiz 1 & 2, Gawilan, Mamrashan, Shekhan, Khanke, Bajed Kandala, Sinjar, Sinuni. The other project which is in partnership with UNHCR that responds to reduce S/GBV in Domiz 1, Gawilan, Akre camps and urban areas. The main activities of those projects are providing psychological and sychosocial support, case managment, S/GBV awareness raising and recreational activities such as computer classes, sewing, basic litracy, yoga sessions, dancing, drawing in order to enhance the healing process of both GBV and non GBV survivors to heal after traumatic events in their lives, Adolescent girls sessions to empower girls to speak up and support one another, GBV awarness session.



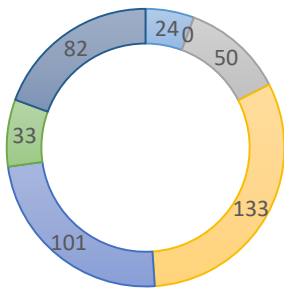
In The WASH Cluster we have two projects that deal with WASH, the first one in partnership with CARE International in Chamishku and Shekhan camps. This project conducts care and maintenance of WASH facilities, Desludging, garbage collection, Hygiene promotion, gender mainstreaming in WASH and capacity building of staff and community. the other project that deals with WASH is funded by CARE BMZ that conducts Construction and rehabilitation of water structure and Sanitation sessions in Zumar and Sinjar area.

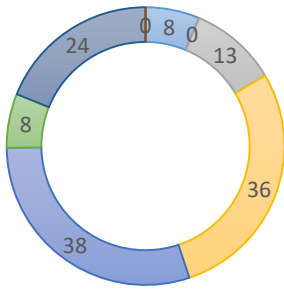


GENERAL HIGHLIGHTS

- As every month we are facing challenges to extract the data from ASSIST website due to the instability and updating, this led to delay exporting (xforms) and other data from the server and led to delay generating the monthly report.
- The lawyers face challenges accessing the civil registration offices during their visit to camps due to not receiving the required support they mentioned to UNHCR/Harikar, which delays the follow up on the beneficiary cases.
- There has been a new procedure in which the PoC's proof of attendance will not take place in Shekhan where they have access to, the new procedure is that the beneficiaries would have to travel to their civil registration office themselves to get their proof of attendance that are only in Sinjar and Tilkef, which is a major challenge for the beneficiaries in terms of transportation and security. We suggest an advocacy taking place for these beneficiaries.
- A coordination meeting with the office of Commission for Investigation and Gathering Evidence in Duhok took place in order to ease the legal procedures for the ISIS survivors in terms of time, which will help beneficiaries to receive their documents sooner.
- Harikar-protection unit organized an internal capacity building training for all the staff. Members from protection, community based protection and legal teams have delivered subjects related to the field of our work. The training was fruitful for all the staff, and it has been concluded in one day re-treat.

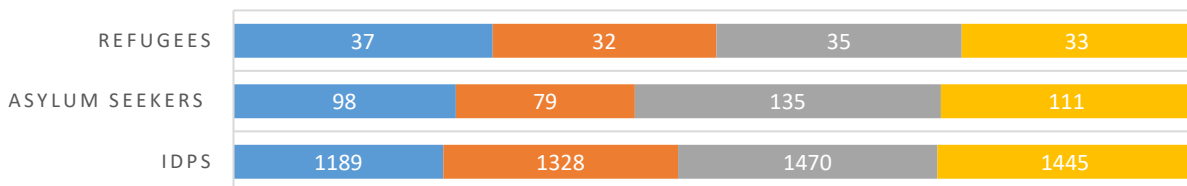

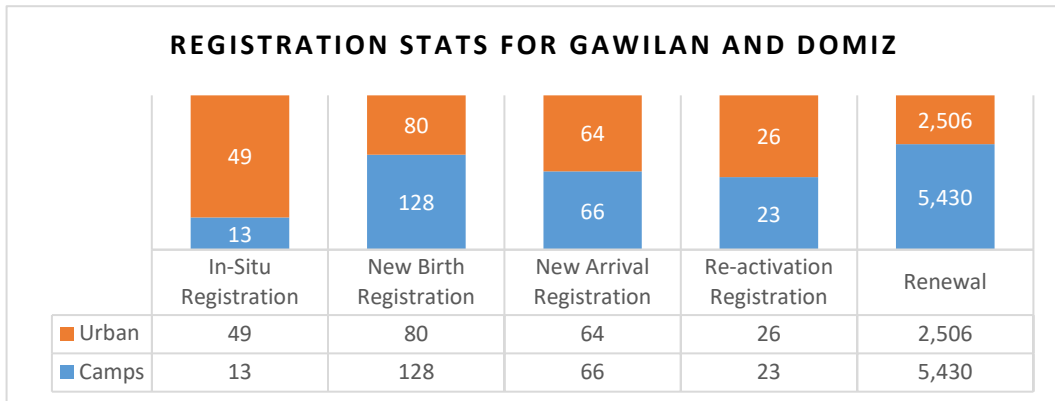

- Protection Monitoring (PMT) Men





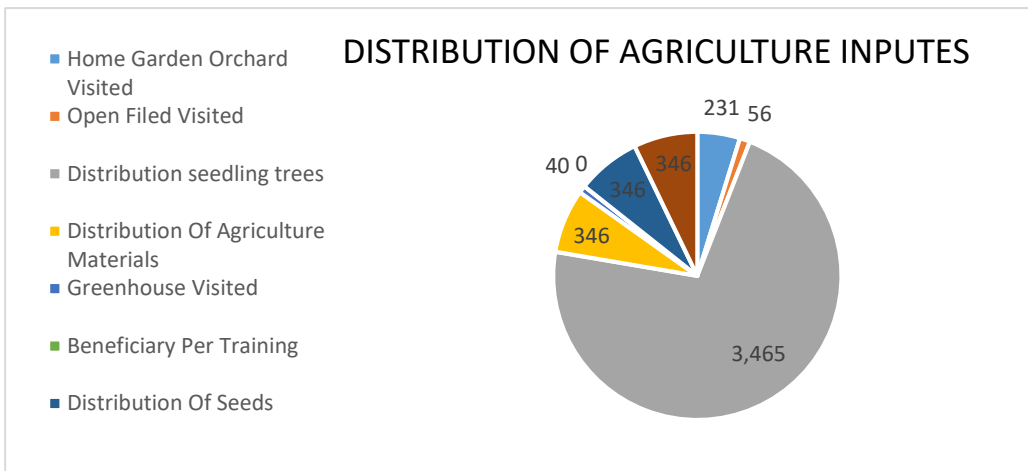
Registration

GENERAL HIGHLIGHTS

- On April 2019, different agriculture inputs fertilizers, biological control drip irrigation system and hand tools metallic water tank were distributed on 487 home garden orchard beneficiaries from Karakafir and Aljazeera villages.
- On 7th and 10th of April the Olive, Pomegranate, Fig, Barrier and Bin seedling were distributed on 231 selected beneficiaries in Karakair, Aljazeera and Bazan villages. Then from 11th to 18th of same month the necessary monitoring have been done for mentioned beneficiaries on planting distributed seedling. The result was that all the beneficiaries planted

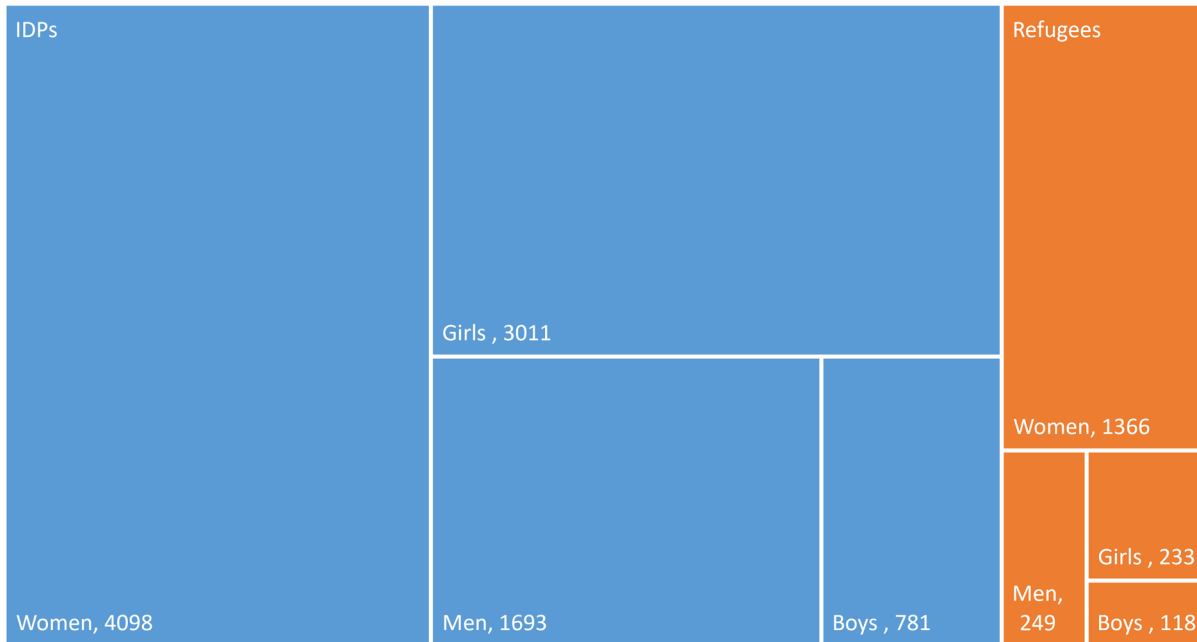

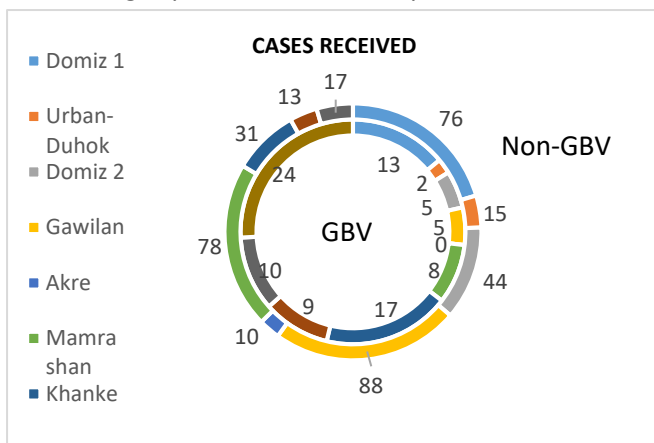

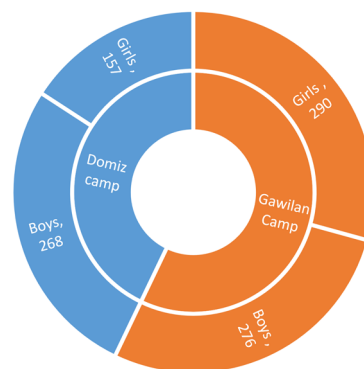


GENERAL HIGHLIGHTS

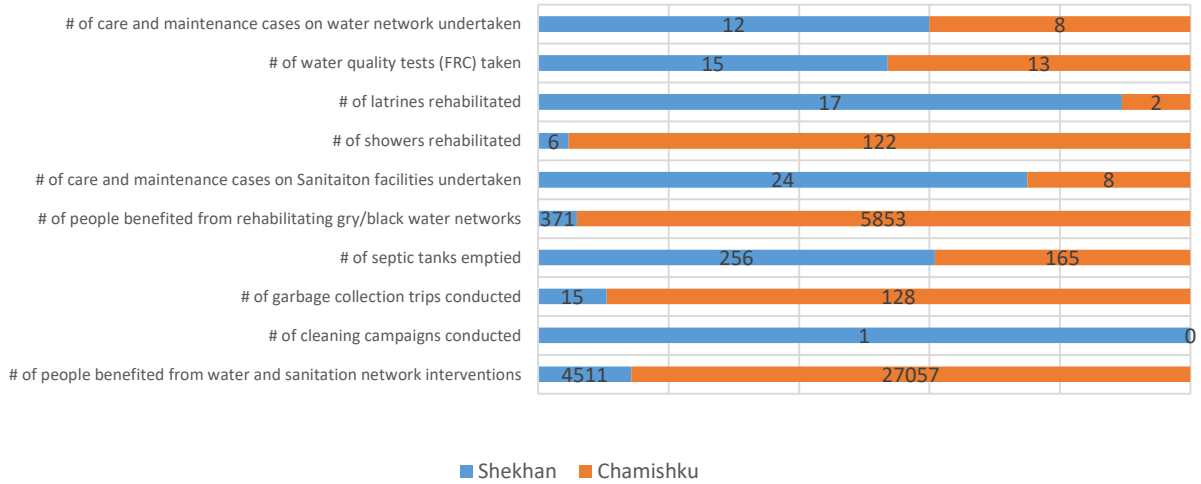


COMMUNITY ACTIVITY CENTERS BENEFICIARIES

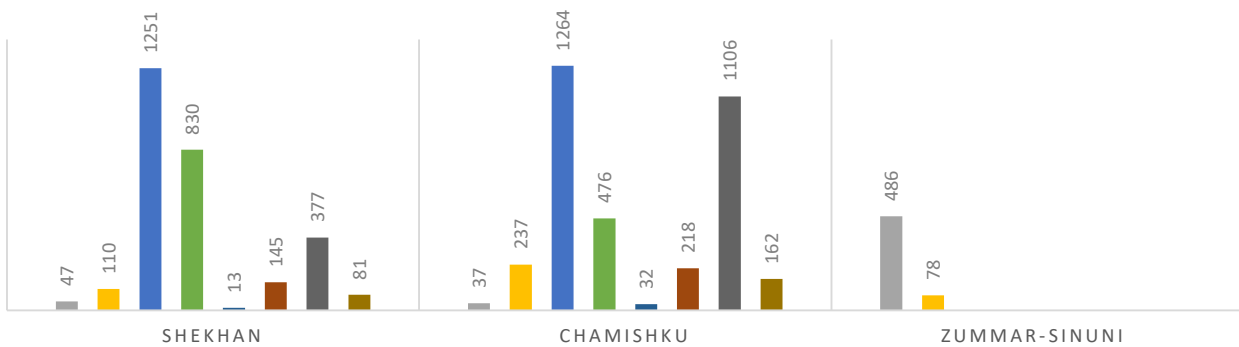


GENERAL HIGHLIGHTS

- A training was conducted for WASH committee members on plumbing.

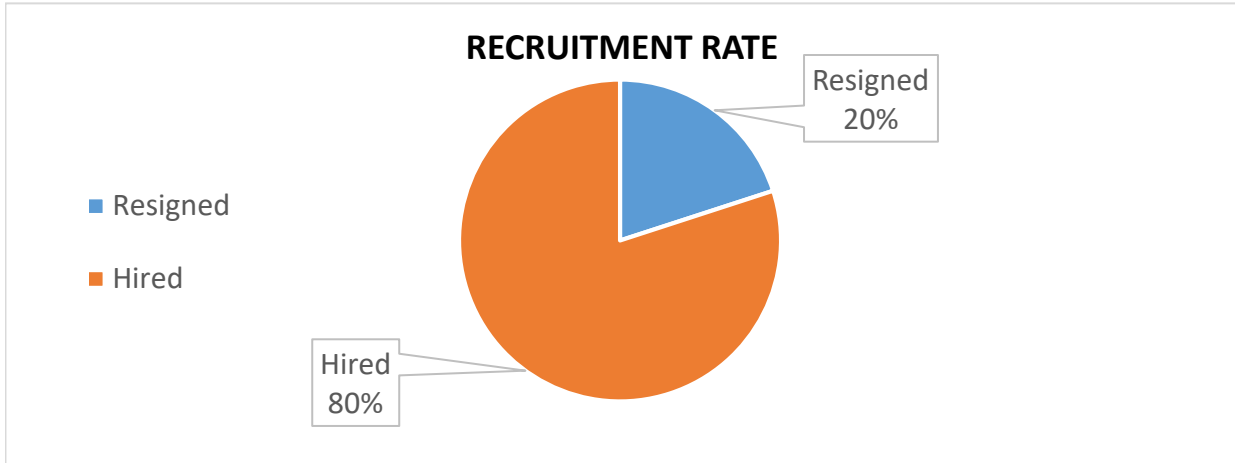
