1.1 Purpose

The purpose of this Request for Tender (RFT) is to solicit competitive, sealed, quote to establish a PO/Contract with a supplier for the provisioning of **(Medical equipment's)**.

1.2 Deadline for Proposal Submission and Inquiries

Deadline for submission is **12:00 P.M** (Iraqi Time) **on 09/12/2021**. No offers will be accepted after this time.

Deadline for written inquiries about this solicitation are accepted before close of business on **30/11/2021**.

All answers to the inquiries received will be published before close of business on **02/12/2021**.

1.3 Offer Submission:

Offers must be submitted using the separate offer system, i.e. in two separate, emails, one bearing the words 'Envelope A — Technical offer' sent to irq-tender-technical@sams-usa.net and the other 'Envelope B — Financial offer' sent to irq-tender-financial@sams-usa.net. All parts of the offer other than the financial offer must be submitted in Envelope A (i.e. Eligibility documents, Supplier declarations). Each technical offer and financial offer must signed and stamped by the vendor.

Failure to fulfil the above requirements will constitute an irregularity and may result in rejection of the offer.

1.4 Method of Payment

Payment(s) will be made within thirty (30) days through **(bank transfer)** after the full delivery, installation, testing and commissioning of the items required. The payment will be conducted following full acceptance by Syrian American Medical Society (SAMS) of the items contracted as a result of duly signed Purchase Order.

1.5 Currency and Language

Offers must be submitted in **English** with prices stated in **(USD)**.

1.6 Terms and Validity of the Agreement

The contract resulting from this RFT will commence upon signing of the Purchase Order by

1.7 Presentations or Demonstrations

All qualified short-listed bidders may be requested to submit samples of required items for inspection and license documentation for review by Syrian American Medical Society (SAMS) after the bid opening. The bidder(s) awarded the Agreement will be bound to deliver the same quality of samples and documents as demonstrated during this stage of the RFT.

1.8 Cancellation

The Syrian American Medical Society (SAMS) reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids, and to accept the bid deemed to be in the best interest of The Syrian American Medical Society (SAMS), and is not bound to accept the lowest price bid submitted. The Syrian American Medical Society (SAMS) reserves the right to cancel this RFT at any time prior to award, without any liability or damages whatsoever.

1.9 Conflict of Interest

By submitting a response to this RFT, Bidders warrants that, to the best of their knowledge, no Syrian American Medical Society (SAMS) employee, officer, consultant or other party related to The Syrian American Medical Society (SAMS) has a financial interest in the Bidder's business activities. Discovery of an undisclosed Conflict of Interest situation will result in immediate disqualification of the bidder and disqualification of the bidder from participation in future Syrian American Medical Society (SAMS) RFT processes.

1.10 Contact

To ensure fair consideration for all bidders, The Syrian American Medical Society (SAMS) prohibits communication to, or with, any Syrian American Medical Society (SAMS) employee during the RFT process, with the exception of those questions related to interpretation of specifications or the proposal process. Any non-related communications initiated by a bidder may be grounds for disqualifying the offending bidder from further participation in this, or future, Syrian American Medical Society (SAMS) RFT processes. 1.11 Anti-Terrorism

The bidder acknowledges that United States Executive Orders and Laws, including but not limited to E.O. 13224 and P.L. 107-56, prohibit transactions with, and the provision of resources and support to, individuals and organizations associated with terrorism. It is the legal responsibility of the bidder to ensure compliance with these Executive Orders and Laws.

1.12 Offers Validity

Offers submitted in response to this RFT should be valid for **60 days**. Prices shall be fixed throughout the duration of the Agreement.

1.13 Partial Quotation:

SAMS will not consider partial offers.

1.14 Partial Awarding:

SAMS has the right to proceed with partial awarding where the contract could be divided between several suppliers according to SAMS interest

2. Method of Evaluation and Award

2.1 Evaluation Criteria

The offers shall be evaluated by a committee consisting of a minimum of (3) members based on the following criteria:

1. Eligibility Criteria:

suppliers submitting an offer as companies should demonstrate their eligibility to participate by providing the below documents:

- Company Registration Documents issued by the official entities

(Any supplier failing to provide the above documents may lose his right in the competition).

2. Pre-qualification criterions: Suppliers must demonstrate having the following pre qualification criterions to be considered for the technical evaluation:

- Previous experience in a similar field and with the same or similar type of requirements
- Successful past performance experience accompanied with certificates from their respective clients
- Completeness of the proposal file with providing catalogues.
- Access and ability to deliver and install in North East Syria.

3. Technical Evaluation: The offer will be technically evaluated according to the following criterions:

- **Brand:20**
- **Quality:15**
- **Origin:15**

4. Financial Evaluation: Offers who pass the technical evaluation will proceed to the financial evaluation, whereas the financial evaluation constitutes 50% of the overall evaluation.

The Syrian American Medical Society (SAMS) may, in its best interest, elect to enter into negotiations with one or more of the apparent responsive and responsible bidders.

3. Proposal Response Format

3.1 Cost to Prepare

The Syrian American Medical Society (SAMS) is not liable for any costs incurred by the bidders in response to this RFT.

3.2 Required Marking on the Proposal

All offers submitted in response to this RFT must be submitted based on two separate emails system and as demonstrated in article 1.3, one bearing the words '**Envelope A — Technical offer**' and the other '**Envelope B — Financial offer**'. The email subject line must clearly state "**RFT-DHK-2021-01**".

3.3 Proposal Format and Support Documentation

The offer submitted must explicitly state and include the following. Failure to supply all requested information and documents or comply with the specified formats may disqualify the bidder from consideration.

1. Supplier Information Form (format provided as attachment to this RFT):

- Name and contact information of person submitting the proposal
- Full names of the company owners

2. Technical proposal:

- Fill the Brand – Model – Origin of the technical table below.
- Fill the Yes/No/Value or QTY of the technical table below.

- Technical catalogs for each item requested.

3. Price proposal (format provided as attachment to this RFT):

- Detailed specifications and price per individual item offered, including all applicable taxes and indication of currency

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- Lead time required from the moment of signing a Purchase Order.
- Price validity period.

4. Cost / Price Proposal

Bidders shall provide detailed pricing information on the Price Offer (format provided as attachment to this RFT).

All submitted documents must be stamped and signed by the Bidder.

SAMS Safeguarding Statement – Procurement

SAMS is committed to protect the served community from all forms of harm specifically sexual exploitation, exploitation, sexual abuse and abuse – SEA, to protect SAMS work environment from all forms of sexual harassment and harassment – SHH, to fulfill SAMS endeavors to protect children from child abuse and to stand against all forms of child labor¹, all SAMS collaborators² are required to adhere to SAMS safeguarding terms.

This Statement is a part of all contractual agreements that might take place between SAMS and any third party that could be considered as a collaborator according to SAMS terms. All contractual agreements with any collaborator cannot be officially acknowledged by SAMS unless if this statement is fully signed and acknowledged by the concerned third party, this extends to

the level that SAMS will not accept any contractual agreement between any of SAMS country offices and any collaborator unless if this statement is included as an annex and fully signed simultaneously with the signing the contractual agreement.

The Statement Terms

1. The collaborator is prohibited from using child labor in the delivery of goods or services under this contract. For the purposes of this statement, child labor includes all full-time work by any child younger than 18 or the basic minimum age for completing mandatory schooling, whichever is younger and also includes any work which, by its nature or the circumstances in which it is carried out, is likely to harm the health, safety, or morals of children ("hazardous work").
2. If any children in employment or in any other forms of contractual engagements will be used in the delivery of any services, this must be declared in writing to SAMS for approval prior to the start of work on the contract. As part of this declaration, any children between the ages of 15-18 must be specifically identified along with a description of their duties and work hours. In narrow circumstances and with prior written permission from SAMS, children from age 15-18 may perform part-time, non hazardous work in the delivery of goods/services to the extent that it does not hinder their education or violate local and international laws.
3. If the collaborator is engaged in delivering services to SAMS beneficiaries, sexual relationships with beneficiaries by its employees will not be tolerated since they are based on inherently unequal power dynamics. They are also strictly prohibited from engaging in sexual activity with children (persons under the age of 18) regardless of the age of majority or age of consent locally, or exchanging money, employment, goods, or services for sexual favors.
4. The collaborator, its employees and its subcontractors are prohibited from engaging in verbal³ or physical abuse⁴ of any individual.
5. The collaborator, its employees and its subcontractors are prohibited from using any personal data of SAMS beneficiaries or SAMS staff for any purposes that may fall out of the defined scope of work within the contractual agreement and any use of SAMS data, out of the defined scope, must be requested, in written, and approved from SAMS senior management which may

¹**Child labor** is defined as work carried out to the detriment and endangerment of a person under the age of 18 ("a child"), in violation of international law and national legislation. It either deprives children of schooling or requires them to assume the dual burden of schooling and work. Child labor is distinct from children in employment, which includes children performing work that is appropriate to both age and development (that does not affect their health and personal development), and that does not interfere with learning.

²**Collaborators and or affiliates:** individuals who work for SAMS as non-staff members including consultants, holders of Agreements for Performance of Work (APW), Special Service Agreements (SSA) or letters of agreement, Temporary Advisers, Interns, and volunteers, as well as third party entities such as vendors, contractors or technical partners who have a contractual relationship with SAMS.

³**Verbal abuse** includes profane language, racist, ableist, or sexist terminology, and any other conduct that would be judged abusive by a reasonable person.

⁴**Physical abuse** includes violent actions (including slapping, punching, kicking, pinching and throwing or damaging objects), creation of discomfort (refusing to turn on heat or air conditioning), repetitive or punitive work assignments, unpaid or poorly paid domestic labor, and any other conduct that would be judged abusive by a reasonable person.

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include SAMS HQ senior management in cases where the data hold by the collaborator are considered as a high sensitive data by SAMS end or in cases where the collaborator may hold personal data on SAMS served population or SAMS personnel.

6. Prior to any contractual agreement between SAMS entities and any collaborator, SAMS will perform the needed background checks regarding the collaborator including ATS checks, security checks and any other checks that SAMS might find the need to search about background and history of the collaborator.

7. Prior to any contractual agreement between SAMS entities and any collaborator, the collaborator is asked to sign SAMS code of conduct. The collaborator reserves the right to request clarification and induction on any documents provided by SAMS at the contracting stage.
8. Once the agreement is fully executed, SAMS will provide collaborators with information on the Safeguarding policy, accountability channels, and any pertinent standard operating procedures to ensure compliance with the policies set forth.
9. Collaborators have the duty to report any concerns or suspicions regarding sexual abuse or exploitation by humanitarian workers, whether in the same agency or not, they must report such concerns via established SAMS reporting mechanisms. Concerns can be reported anonymously to SAMS through the whistleblowing system⁵, CFRM, or SAMS safeguarding and accountability website [link](#).

Violation of the statement

In case the SEA, SHH or Child abuse case is committed by the collaborator or its employees, SAMS mandates to receive an incident report of the case within 24 hours and subsequent information on the investigation and implemented corrective actions. In the case that SAMS is not satisfied with the results of the investigation, SAMS holds the right to proceed with its own investigation or audit the investigation process. In the case of a collaborator abstaining from providing SAMS with timely reporting of incidents, SAMS reserves the right of terminating the collaboration agreement. In cases of SHH, and if the staff of a SAMS collaborator chooses to report the case to SAMS's accountability channels, then SAMS reserves the right to proceed with investigative procedures in accordance with SAMS Safeguarding policy and investigation protocol.

SAMS reserves the right to record of any individuals or entities found to have engaged in, encouraged or condoned acts of SEA, Child Abuse and or SHH from participating in future tenders, recruitments and entering into future contractual relationships with SAMS.

Disclosure

SAMS reserves the right to share information concerning cases of SEA, Child Abuse and or SHH committed by any of SAMS collaborators, its staff or its subcontractors with other UN agencies; INGOs and NGOs. When required, SAMS is keen to fulfill its commitment to the [Inter-Agency Misconduct Disclosure Scheme](#).⁶

Liaising with Local Authorities

SAMS Entities shall evaluate reporting safeguarding violations to appropriate legal authorities, assessing any legal obligations to report, as well as the interests of the survivor(s). Generally, reports are made, unless a report is judged likely to cause greater harm to existing victims or potential future victims, or in case the survivor has given a written statement stating the refusal to communicate the case with the local authorities. In the case of a survivor's refusal to report the case to the authorities, SAMS will be bound to this statement respecting the survivor wishes, but will also fulfill the responsibility of explaining the importance of engaging the local authorities on the case.
